Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on January 28, 1935, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Talus, in the County of Inyo, and to remove a side track, approximately 3,016 feet in length, located at said station.

Applicant states that no freight or passenger business has been transacted at this station for more than two years and that the continued maintenance of these facilities is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appears that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREEY ORDERED that the Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Talus, in the County of Inyo, State of California, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station and to abandon and remove its

side track, approximately 3,016 feet in length, located at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authorization herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
