ORDER AUTHORIZING REROUTING

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Yosemite Park and Curry Company,  
operating automotive passenger and baggage service between  
Fresno and Yosemite National Park (Horseshoe Route Division), be  
and it hereby is authorized to use as an alternate route on said  
division a new highway between a point five (5) miles east of  
Coarse Gold and Fish Camp, via Oakhurst, in addition to the routes  
named in Decisions Nos. 13686 and 13720, on Application No. 9107,  
and Decision No. 16681, on Application No. 12787, with authority  
to use either or all routes as safety and expedition may require.
