Ferrari operating under the name and style of Placerville-Crizzly Flats Stage, having advised the Commission in writing that he has discontinued his automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Placerville and Grizzly Flats and intermediate points of Pleasant Valley, Cole's and Young's, and

December 3, 1928 on Application No. 15184 establishing the operating right herein referred to, be and the same hereby is revoked and all tariffs and time schedules thereunder hereby are cancelled.
