FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 27674 herein applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity with the reservation that such preliminary grant should not become effective until applicant had filed with this Commission a map "showing all the routes applicant proposes to traverse, the points and termini of each route and seven (7) miles laterally therefrom" and which map should be approved and an effective date of the order fixed.

Southern Pacific Company, a protestant, and applicant agree that a stipulation entered into between them and other rail carriers should become a part of the final order, imposing restrictions on the movements of applicant. The final order will modify the original order to conform with the stipulation.

The map, as filed, appears consistent with the preliminary order and will be approved.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the map and routes of the area proposed to be served by applicant under Decision No. 27674 herein, be and the same hereby are approved.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rights heretofore granted by Decision No. 27674 herein be and they are hereby made subject to the following restriction :

Applicant may transport northbound, from farms only, to commission houses, markets and packing plants in San Francisco and/or Oakland, fresh fruits, fresh berries and fresh vegetables, and to transport southbound, to farms only, the following:
returning empty containers, fertilizers, farm machinery and parts therefor; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that no different nor greater service shall be performed under the certificate heretofore and herein granted than is contained in said restriction upon the commodities to be transported.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from date hereof.
