BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company having asked the Commission to rescind and set aside paragraph three of the order in Decision No. 12762 dated October 27, 1923, reading--

" Each year beginning with the calendar year 1923 Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company account to its Reserve for Accrued Depreciation of Electric Department Property for an annuity calculated in accordance with the principles followed in the opinion preceding this order and also for interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum upon the balance of the Reserve for Accrued Depreciation on the First day of each year. Such Reserve for Accrued Depreciation shall be applicable to the retirement of only that property considered in the decision preceding this order as operative in the electric department;"

and the Commission having considered applicant's request and being of the opinion that good cause appears for such request and that such request should be granted, as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said paragraph three of the order in Decision No. 12762 dated October 27, 1923, be, and the same is hereby, rescinded and set aside, subject to the condition that said Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company credit Account #241, Depreciation Reserve-Electric Property, annually or monthly with an

amount representing an appropriate annuity calculated on a six per cent sinking fund basis, and until the interest deficiency in the Depreciation Reserve-Electric Property is made up, credit said reserve with a further sum which shall be not less than interest earned on such Depreciation Reserve-Electric Property.
