O R D E R

Andrew Johnson, owning and operating a water system under the fictitious firm name and style of Jersey Flat Water Works and engaged in the business of selling and distributing water for domestic purposes to the residents of Downieville, Sierra County, having made application to this Commission for authority to sell and transfer said water works to W.J. Peckwith, who owns and operates a water system under the fictitious firm name and style of Durgan Flat Water Works, also engaged in the business of selling and distributing water to the residents of a certain portion of Downieville for domestic purposes, and who joins in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Andrew Johnson be and he is hereby authorized to sell and transfer to W.J. Peckwith that certain water system known as Jersey Flat Water Works and the properties appurtenant thereto used in supplying water for domestic purposes to residents in Downieville, Sierra County, as more par-

ticularly described in the proposed indenture attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference, subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of June, 1935, and a certified copy of the final instrument or instruments of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Andrew Johnson within thirty (30) days from the date on which said instrument or instruments are executed.
2. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
3. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Andrew Johnson actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred or within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
