OPINION and ORDER

Otis E. Hines, operating an automotive service under the name and style of Bieber Alturas Stage Line, for the transportation of property between Alturas and Bieber and intermediate points of Canby, Adin and Lookout, seeks authority of this Commission to discontinue all service and for a further order revoking his operating right.

Applicant states that he has lost a creamery haul and alleges that the remaining public business is not sufficient to warrant profitable operation.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is unnecessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Otis E. Hines, operating under the name and style of Bieber-Alturas Stage Line, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all service for the transportation of property between Alturas and Bieber and the intermediate points of Canby, Adin and Lookout and, further, that all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and they are hereby canceled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 27402, dated September 29, 1934, on Application No. 19596, be and it is hereby revoked.
