OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

Yosemite Park and Curry Co., operating seasonal passenger stage service between Merced and Yosemite Valley, via Mariposa Grove, requests authority to suspend such service between May 1st and October 1, 1935. The service is part of applicant's "Horseshoe" Division. Traffic is now wholly between Merced and El Portal and between Fresno and Wawona, due to train and highway connections. The service was suspended by authority of this Commission during the season of 1934.

The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Yosemite Park and Curry Co. be and it is hereby authorized to suspend all service between Merced and Yosemite Valley, via Mariposa Grove and Wawona, from May 1, 1935, to October 1, 1935, provided applicant shall file with the Railroad Commission, within ten (10) days after date hereof, suspension of its time schedules and fares therefor.
