FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In their supplemental application filed on February 27, 1935, applicants ask the Commission to amend its order in Decision No. 26487 dated November 4, 1933, so as to authorize them to set up on their books of account, as gas sales to unemployed persons, members of Co-operative Units, individually certified and approved by the office of the Federal Emergency Relief Administrator, only that amount represented as the net sum billed, after subtraction of the discount, and to charge to uncollectibles, in connection therewith, only such amounts as actually become uncollectible in these accounts in the same manner as in the case of other ordinary and regular consumers accounts. Under said Decision No. 26487 dated November 4, 1933 as it now reads, applicants bill the said consumers at the regular meter rates, but discount such bills seventy-five per cent. The discount is now charged to uncollectibles.

The Commission has considered applicants' request and believes that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in said Decision No. 26487 dated November 4, 1933, be, and the same is, hereby amended so as to authorize Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation, Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California to account for gas sold to those certain consumers mentioned in said Decision No. 26487, dated November 4, 1933, in the manner outlined in the supplemental petition filed herein on February 27, 1935.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in said Decision No. 26487 dated November 4, 1933 shall remain in full force and effect, except as amended by this First Supplemental Order.
