ORDER APPROVING WHARF FRANCHISE

Applicant by verified petition, asks this Commission to approve an ordinance of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, granting to applicant permission to construct, operate and maintain a wharf on lands bordering on Estero Bay and extending into the waters thereof, in said County, which wharf is to be used by applicant solely for its own private commercial purposes, it not being intended that the public shall gee the wharf or that tolls shall be collected.

Approval of this Commission to the grant of such franchise is required by Political Code, Section 2906. It appearing that such approval should be given, and that public hearing is not required, IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby accorded for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a wharf by Standard Oil Company of California in San Luis Obispo County, as provided by Ordinance of the Board of Supervisors of said County dated February 18, 1935.
