OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding the Railroad Commission has been asked to make an order authorizing the transfer of the business properties and assets of Pioneer Truck & Storage Co., a corporation located at San Diego, including its right to operate as a public warehouseman, to Lyon Van & Storage Co.

The application sets forth that it is proposed to transfer all of the assets of Pioneer Truck & Storage Co., including the aforesaid franchise, to Lyon Van & Storage Co. and thereafter to dissolve Pioneer Truck & Storage Co.; that no consideration will be given by Lyon Van & Storage Co. for the aforesaid transfer of said assets, including said franchise, but the consent by all of the stockholders of Pioneer Truck & Storage Co. will be obtained to such transfer.

Copy of Resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of Pioneer Truck & Storage Co. and Lyon Van & Storage Co. authorizing the transfer is attached to and made a part of the application.

Lyon Van & Storage Co. will continue to operate the warehouse as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown

in Warehouse Tariff No. 14, C.R.C. No. 63 of the California Warehouse Tariff Bureau, L. A. Bailey, Agent, effective July 1, 1933, supplements thereto or reissue thereof. The proposed transfer will not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a formal hearing and that the application should be granted; therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. Pioneer Truck & Storage Co. and Lyon Van & Storage Co. shall join in common supplement to the tariff now on file with the Railroad Commission, applicant Pioneer Truck & Storage Co. on the one hand withdrawing and applicant Lyon Van & Storage Co. on the other hand accepting and adopting such tariff.
2. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be conveyed may not be sold, leased, transferred nor assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, assignment or discontinuance has first been secured.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
