ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

By Decision No. 6968, dated December 19, 1919, on Application No. 3546, and Decision No. 14691, dated March 24, 1925, on Application No. 9805, William J. Azevedo, operating under the name and style of Half Moon Bay Stage Line, was authorized by the Commission to operate an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and express between San Mateo and Half Moon Bay and intermediate points of County Hospital, Mt. House, Summit and Pilarcitos Creek.

Under date of March 20, 1935, Azevedo advised this Commission, in writing, that he had not operated since April 15, 1934, and did not wish to continue his certificated service. Therefore,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decisions Nos. 6968 and 14691, dated December 19, 1919, and March 24, 1925, respectively, be and they hereby are revoked and annulled and further that all tariffs and time schedules thereunder be and they hereby are canceled.
