

Decision No. 27863

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

a corporation, for: (1) Order authorizing sale of certain public utility properties; and (2) Order authorizing said corporation to discontinue public utility operations; and the application of  
SAN JOSE WATER WORKS, a corporation, for: (1) Order authorizing purchase of capital stock of a public utility corporation; (2) Order authorizing purchase of certain public utility properties; (3) Order authorizing mortgage of public utility properties; (4) Order authorizing issue and sale of bonds and stocks.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, San Jose Water Works has on deposit with American Trust Company, trustee, \$151,452.88 received from the sale of bonds authorized by Decision No. 27267 dated August 9, 1934; and

WHEREAS, said San Jose Water Works may expend said \$151,452.88 or any part thereof, only for such purposes as are authorized by the Railroad Commission; and

WHEREAS, said San Jose Water Works in its supplemental petition filed on March 22, 1935 asks permission to use \$33,273.14 of said \$151,452.88 to reimburse its treasury because of expenditures for additions and betterments to its water supply and distribution system during the period of December 1, 1934 to February 28, 1935; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has considered applicant's request and believes that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Jose Water Works be, and it hereby is, authorized to withdraw from American Trust Company, trustee, under its trust indenture of July 1, 1926, as amended, \$33,273.14 of the proceeds received from the issue and sale of the bonds authorized by Decision No. 27267, dated August 9, 1934, for the purpose of reimbursing its treasury on account of moneys expended for additions and betterments made to its water system during the period from December 1, 1934 to February 28, 1935, as follows:-
