## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph No.5 of the order in Decision No.27766 herein, issued February 25, 1935, be and the same is amended by inserting therein, after the phrase "Application No.14544" the following:

"for unified service between termini and all intermediate points, including Bly Stone quarry, Paradise Camp, Rock Creek, Hans Loff's, Mc Gee Creek, Eaton's Ranch, Convict Crossing, Casa Diablo, Camp High Sierra, Mammoth, Crestview, Tamarack Lodge, Crystal Crag, June Lake, Gull Lake, Fern Crest, Silver Lake and and June Lake Junction and five miles on each side

Application No. 19339 "of High Sierras Highway, provided no local service between Bishop and Mono Lake is hereby authorized, but applicant is authorized to serve all points named either directly on High Sierras Highway, or by diversion over public roads thereto."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No.27766 remain unaltered.
