ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

The Commission by order dated February 1, 1935, suspended until June 4, 1935, Item 357, Original Page 73-AA of Southern California Freight Forwarders' Local Express Tariff 1, C.R.C. 1, providing reduced rates for the transportation of alcoholic beverages between Burbank and Los Angeles. The tariff was suspended upon protests from competing common carriers who alleged among other things that the rates were non-compensatory and unjustified.

The matter was set for public hearing at Los Angeles. Before the proceeding was heard however respondent informed the Commission that it desired to withdraw the suspended rates. Permission to do so was granted by the Commission and the suspended schedule has been canceled effective March 26, 1935. The cause for suspension has thus been removed and our order of February 1, 1935, should be vacated and this proceeding discontinued.
