

Decision No. 27895.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to (a) abandon the non-agency station of Trescape, in the County of Kern, State of California, and (b) to abandon and remove the side track approximately 2894 feet in length, located at said station.

Application No. 19901.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, on April 3, 1935, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Trescape, in Kern County, on its Owenyo Branch, and to remove a side track approximately 2894 feet in length, located at this station. Applicant states that no business has been transacted at this point during the past 36 months.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Trescape, in Kern County, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rates, tariffs and time schedules applying at said station, and to abandon and remove a side track located at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become

void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
