BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In its Decision No. 24698 dated April 13, 1932, this
Commission ordered as follows:

- (1) That Southern Counties Gas Company of Cali-
fornia shall file with this Commission a
certified copy of the above mentioned fran-
chises duly authorized by the County of
San Diego, the City of San Diego and the
City of Oceanside.
- (2) That Southern Counties Gas Company of Cali-
fornia shall file with this Commission
stipulations, duly executed on authority
of its Board of Directors, agreeing that it
will never claim for said franchises a value
in excess of the cost thereof.
- (3) That San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric
Company shall file with this Commission a
certified copy of the aforesaid agreement
duly executed on proper authority of the re-
spective applicants herein.

- (4) That said franchises, stipulations and agreement shall be filed with this Commission on or before June 1, 1932.
- (5) That upon filing of the franchises, stipulations and agreement, above referred to, in proper form, and within the period above set forth, the Commission shall issue its Supplemental Order authorizing the exercise of the rights conferred by such franchises.

By its Decision No. 24810 dated May 24, 1932, the Commission, at applicant's request, extended the filing date set forth in Condition (4) above from June 1, 1932 to August 1, 1932. Applicants having complied with the conditions above set forth within the time specified;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas Company of California be and it is hereby granted a certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and authorized to exercise the rights and privileges granted to it by the ordinances set forth in this Commission's Decision No. 24698, provided that the Railroad Commission may hereafter by appropriate proceedings and orders, revoke or limit as to territory not then served by Southern Counties Gas Company of California, or its successors in interest, the authority herein granted.

In all other respects Decision No. 24698 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
