O R D E R

E. Burr, doing business as a public utility water company under the firm name and style of Central Gardens Water Company in the County of Los Angeles, having made application as entitled above and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted as herein provided, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's Order in Decision No. 21485, issued the 23rd day of August, 1929, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby declares that public convenience and necessity require that E. Burr, doing business under the fictitious firm name and style of Central Gardens Water Company, operate a water system for the purpose of supplying water for domestic and irrigation use on Tracts Nos. 7984, 5103, 10587, 10442, 10634, 6728 and 33.485 acres adjacent, lying between Wright road and Flood Control, Los Angeles County.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's Decision No. 21485 shall remain in full force and effect except as amended by

the Order herein.

For all other purposes the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
