OPINION and ORDER

William Deysher and Bernard Lafargue, co-partners, have made application to the Commission for authority to suspend, for a period of one year, their automotive operation for the transportation of milk and dairy products between the City and County of San Francisco and Novato and Reclamation, Marin county, as authorized by Decision No. 17833, dated January 5, 1927, on Application No. 11094.

Applicant alleges that dairies or shippers are hauling the milk at the present time and therefore no profitable operation by applicants is possible.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is unnecessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that William Deysher and Bernard Lafargue, co-partners, be and they are hereby authorized to suspend all operations for the automotive transportation of milk and dairy products between the City and County of San Francisco and Novato and Reclamation, Marin county, as authorized by Decision No. 17833, on Application No. 11094, from June 1, 1935, until June 1, 1936, provided that applicants shall file, in triplicate, and make effective within a period not to exceed twenty (20) days from the effective date of

this order and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public supplements to their tariffs,- also a time schedule showing such suspension as authorized herein.

This order shall become effective upon date of signature.
