ORDER

East Bay Street Railways, Ltd., a corporation, on April 17, 1935, applied for authority to abandon street railway service and remove its tracks on the following described portion of its No. 7 line in the city of Oakland:

Beginning at 12th and Kirkham Streets and running thence on Kirkham Street to 13th Street, thence along 13th Street to Center Street, thence along Center Street to 12th Street.

The track applicant proposes to abandon is slightly over one block in length and is a portion of a loop now operated on 12th and 13th Streets between Kirkham and Center Streets. The applicant states that the track on 13th Street is in poor condition and if service over this portion of the loop is to be continued, a capital expenditure will be necessary in rebuilding and repairing which is not justified.

It appears that the city of Oakland has no objection to the proposed abandonment, that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that East Bay Street Railways, Ltd.,

is hereby authorized to discontinue service and abandon its single track street railway on the above described portion of its No. 7 line in the city of Oakland.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
