OPINION AND ORDER

T. J. Shea has made written request to this Commission for authority to discontinue all automotive service for the transportation of trunks, poultry, eggs and poultry supplies between Los Angeles and Baldwin Park and for a further order revoking his operating right.

Applicant's annual report for 1934, filed with the Commission, shows revenues of \$78.00 and expenses of \$31.60 or an income of \$46.40 which bears out applicant's allegation that business available is not sufficient to warrant operation, it being, for the most part, privately carried.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that T. J. Shea be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all automotive service for the transportation of trunks, poultry, eggs and poultry supplies between Los Angeles and Baldwin Park and further that all tariffs and time schedules therefore be and they hereby are revoked.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 10830

dated August 10, 1922 on Application No. 7890 be and the same hereby is revoked.
