OPINION and ORDER

V. P. Meese, operating under the fictitious name and style of San Diego-Tecate Auto Service, has made application to the Commission for authority to discontinue all service for the transportation of passengers between San Diego and Tecate and the intermediate points of Spring Valley, Jamul, Dulzura, Barrett and Potrero, and for a further order revoking his operating right for such passenger service.

Applicant alleges lack of sufficient patronage for profitable operation, has lost his mail contract as of July 1, 1934, and is, moreover, without equipment to continue his service.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that V.P.Meese, operating under the name and style of San Diego-Tecate Auto Service, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all service for the transportation of passengers between San Diego and Tecate and the intermediate points of Spring Valley, Jamul, Dulzura, Barrett and Potrero and, further, that all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and they hereby are canceled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No.22872, dated September 15, 1930, on Application No.16805, in so far as it refers to the transportation of passengers, be and the same hereby

is revoked; the freight operating right granted under the same decision, No.22872, to remain unaltered, as set forth therein.
