OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

Western Refrigerating Company, a corporation, has made application to this Commission for authority to discontinue all automotive service for the transportation of freight between Petaluma, Penn Grove, Two Rocks, Bloomfield, Bodega, Fallon, Lakeville and Tomales and for a further order revoking the operating right.

Applicant alleges insufficient volume to warrant continued operation. Its annual report for 1934, filed with the Commission, shows only \$28.96 revenue for the period.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western Refrigerating Company be and it hereby is authorized to discontinue all automotive service for the transportation of freight between Petaluma, Penn Grove, Two Rocks, Bloomfield, Bodega, Fallon, Lakeville and Tomales and, further, that all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and they hereby are canceled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the prior right under which applicant herein operated be and the same hereby is revoked.
