O R D E R

C. E. Utt, General Manager of a public utility water system owned by Margaret R. Utt and operating under the fictitious firm name and style of Tustin Water Works and serving water for domestic and irrigation purposes in and in the vicinity of the Town of Tustin, Orange County, California, having made application as entitled above and it appearing that the rate schedule which applicant asks the Railroad Commission to approve amounts to a temporary reduction in charges for said utility, and it further appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that C.E. Utt, General Manager, and/or Margaret Utt, owner of Tustin Water Works, a public utility, be and they are hereby authorized to file with this Commission within thirty (30) days from and after the date hereof the following temporary schedule of rates for service to its consumers in and in the vicinity of the Town of Tustin, Orange County, California, effective for service rendered subsequent to the 31st day of May, 1935:

RATE SCHEDULE

Flat Rate

For unmetered service-----\$1.25 per month

Meter Rates

Monthly Minimum Charges:

5/8-inch meter-----	\$1.25
1-inch meter-----	1.50
1 1/2-inch meter-----	1.50
1 3/4-inch meter-----	2.00
2-inch meter-----	3.00
3-inch meter-----	4.00

The foregoing "Monthly Minimum Charges" will entitle the consumer to the quantity of water which said minimum charge will purchase at the following "Monthly Quantity Rates."

Monthly Quantity Rates:

First 750 cubic feet or fraction thereof-----	\$1.25
750 to 4,000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet-----	.10
4,000 to 20,000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet-----	.08
All over 20,000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet-----	.06

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, at the expiration of one year, the temporary schedule of rates herein authorized may be discontinued and the present schedule of rates again become effective.

For all other purposes the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
