O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and A.N. Sweet, engaged in mining operations in Placer County, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a certain agreement to be entered into by and between the above applicants in accordance with the words and figures as written in the copy thereof marked Exhibit "A", said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery by Pacific Gas and Electric Company to said A.N. Sweet, for mining purposes on certain properties known as the T. W. A. Mine located in the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 16, Township 12 North, Range 8 East, M.D.B. & M., Placer County, such quantity of excess water available in said Company's Fiddler Green Canal, which passes in the vicinity of the aforesaid properties, not exceeding a flow of two (2) miner's inches,⁽¹⁾ to be paid for at the rate of thirty cents (30¢) per miner's inch day,⁽²⁾ said agreement to be effective for

1. A miner's inch for the purpose of this agreement shall mean 1.5 cubic feet of water per minute.

2. A miner's inch day for the purpose of this agreement shall mean one (1) miner's inch as heretofore defined flowing for a period of twenty-four hours.

a period of one year from and after the date of its execution and thereafter until terminated at the election of either Pacific Gas and Electric Company or A.N. Sweet by service on the other party of written notice to that effect thirty (30) days in advance of the date on which such termination shall become effective, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and A.N. Sweet be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
