In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, a California corporation, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise certain franchise rights in the County of Los Angeles, under franchise to be acquired by applicant.

FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In its Decision No. 22640, dated July 9, 1930, in the above numbered application, this Commission ordered, among other things, the following:

"8. Upon the filing of the contract, franchise, stipulations and rates referred to in conditions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 above, this Commission will issue its supplemental order authorizing the exercise by Southern California Gas Company of the rights and privileges granted to it under such franchise."

Applicant having complied with all of the conditions contained in Decision No. 22640, with the exception of Condition (6) which has been rescinded by Decision No. 23048, dated November 5, 1930;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company be and it is hereby granted permission to exercise the rights and privileges granted to it by Ordinance No. 1847 (New Series) of the County of Los Angeles, as referred to in this Commission's Decision No. 22640; provided that the Railroad Commission may hereafter, by appropriate proceedings and orders, revoke or limit

as to territory not then served by Southern California Gas Company, or its successors in interest, the authority herein granted.

In all other respects Decision No. 22640 shall remain in full force and effect save as modified by Decision No. 23048 referred to above.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
