FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In its Decision No. 23628, dated April 27, 1931, in the above numbered application, this Commission ordered as follows:

"(4) That Benbow Power Company shall file with this Commission, on or before June 30, 1931, a stipulation, duly executed upon the authority of its Board of Directors, that applicant, its successors or assigns, will never claim before the Railroad Commission, or any other body or court, a value for said franchises in excess of the actual cost thereof."

Applicant having on July 14, 1931, filed a satisfactory stipulation, as mentioned above, and having complied with the other conditions in Decision No. 23628;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Benbow Power Company be and it is hereby granted permission to exercise the rights and privileges granted to it by Ordinance No. 169 of the County of Humboldt and Ordinance No. 230 of the County of Mendocino, referred to in this Commission's Decision No. 23628; provided that the Railroad Commission may hereafter, by appropriate proceedings and orders, revoke

or limit as to territory not then served by said Benbow Power Company or its successors in interest, the authority herein granted.

In all other respects Decision No. 23628 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
