ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY REROUTING

Whereas, Motor Freight Terminal Company, a corporation, and Valley Motor Lines, Inc., a corporation, transporting shipments consigned to Valley ExpSess Company, an express corporation, find themselves unable, temporarily, to effect through service between Los Angeles and San Francisco by exchange of equipment at Fresno, as authorized by Decision No.27053, dated May 14, 1934, herein; and

whereas, express shipments in large volume require, as a matter of public convenience and necessity, through movement between termini without interruption,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No.8 of Decision No.27053, on Application No.19266, be and the same hereby is amended, by authorizing exchange of equipment between Motor Freight Terminal Company and Valley Motor Lines at San Luis Obispo, in lieu of Fresno, under the terms and conditions of the authority granted each and both, and consistent with the contract thereunder between the carriers, when such equipment transports only ladings consigned over Valley Express Company; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, to effect such temporary exchange of equipment Valley Motor Lines, Inc. be and it hereby is authorized to reroute its vehicles containing said shipments, and no others, over Highway No.101 between San Francisco and San Luis Obispo until such time as said carriers are able to resume exchange of equipment at Fresno, at which time the authority herein granted shall lapse and become void.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said carriers, and each of them, shall notify the Commission, in writing, of the beginning and termination of the emergency exchange at San Luis Obspo.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
