

Decision No. 28022

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of VALLEY MOTOR LINES, INC., a corporation, and MOTOR FREIGHT TERMINAL COMPANY, a corporation, to interchange equipment at San Luis Obispo, California, instead of Fresno, California, in connection with the transportation of property between points on and beyond the lines of Valley Motor Lines, Inc., and points on and beyond the lines of Motor Freight Terminal Company, for Valley Express Co., an express corporation, without transferring loadings from the equipment of one applicant to the equipment of the other applicant.

ORDER REVOKING ORDER

Applicants herein sought authority to reroute shipments of Valley Express Company via Fresno to the coast route in an emergency which prevented the transfer of shipments at Fresno, as provided for by our Decisions Nos. 26942, 27001 and 27053, herein. By Decision No. 28004 herein, issued May 27, 1935, applicants were authorized to divert and reroute their shipments via the coast route with exchange of equipment at San Luis Obispo.

Applicants now advise the Commission that the emergency has abated and that shipments are now being routed by the original route with exchange of equipment at Fresno.

This being a matter in which public hearing is not necessary, the application having served its purpose, and the rerouting having been physically terminated,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 28004, upon Application No. 19266 (supplemental), be and the same hereby is set aside and revoked and all authority thereunder rescinded.
