ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and El Dorado Irrigation District, an irrigation district situate in the County of El Dorado, State of California, having filed an application with the Railroed Commission requesting approval of a written agreement in accordance with the words and figures as written in the copy thereof marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein, said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery by Pacific Gas and Electric Company to said El Dorado Irrigation District, for the purpose of meeting an anticipated emergency in respect to the District's water supply during the coming summer, such quantities of water in excess of the forty (40) second feet provided for in an agreement entered into by and between Western States Gas and Electric Company and El Dorado Water Company under date of May 31, 1919, and approved by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 6436. issued June 25, 1919, in Application No. 4661 (in the meantime

said Pacific Gas and Electric Company having succeeded to all rights and assumed all obligations of said Western States Gas and Electric Company and said El Dorado Irrigation District having succeeded to all rights and assumed all obligations of said El Dorado Water Company) as Pacific Gas and Electric Company may have available therefor from time to time in its El Dorado Canal, not exceeding ten (10) second feet, to be paid for at the rate of twenty cents (20¢) per miner's inch day, said agreement to be effective during the period from noontime of May 15, 1935, to noontime of October 15, 1935, only, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and El Dorado Irrigation be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the delivery of water under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, WITHIN THITY (30) Mays from the date of this Order, two certities copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
