Eva C. Metz having made application as entitled above for permission to quitclaim to Ed Fiss all interest she may have in and to Shasta Retreat Water Works serving Shasta Retreat near the Town of Dunsmuir, Siskiyou County, and said Ed Fiss who has been operating said water system for some time last past having joined in said application, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted as herein provided, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Eva C. Metz be and she is hereby authorized to quitclaim unto Ed Fiss all interest she may have in and to the public utility water system known as Shasta Retreat Water Works, such quitclaim to be made under the terms and conditions of the proposed QUITCLAIM DEED filed with the application herein and which is made a part of this Order by reference.

The authority herein granted is subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall be made on or before the first day of August, 1935, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Eva C. Metz within thirty (30) days from and after the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which said Eva C. Metz actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, she shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
