SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

ORIGINAL

The Los Angeles Brewing Company filed its supplemental application, seeking authority to enlarge its warehouse space, located in the City of Los Angeles, from Ten Thousand (10,000) to Thirty Thousand (30,000) square feet. By this Commission's Decision No. 27103, dated May 28th, 1934, applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the operation of a public utility warehouse at 650 Moulton Avenue, in the City of Los Angeles, with a floor space not to exceed Ten Thousand square feet, for the storage of liquors and wines, only.

Applicant alleges that it has secured from the Treasury Department of the United States Government, Bureau of Industrial Alcohol, authorization to increase the capacity of General Bonded Warehouse No. 7 from Ten Thousand to Thirty Thousand square feet. In connection therewith, a two-story addition to its warehouse at 650 Moulton Avenue has been constructed. No changes are proposed in its charges for storing or for incidental handling of wines and liquors, as set forth in Los Angeles Brewing Company's Tariff No. 1, C.R.C. No. 1.

The Los Angeles Warehousemen's Association, by letter dated May 4th, 1935, has signified that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the declaration set forth in Decision No. 27103, dated May 28th, 1934, on Application No. 19424, be amended to read as follows:

"The Railroad Commission of the State of California Hereby Declares that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Los Angeles Brewing Company of not exceeding Thirty Thousand (30,000) square feet of floor space, as a public utility warehouseman of liquors and wines, only, in the City of Los Angeles, at 650 Moulton Avenue;"

In all other respects, said Decision No. 27103 shall remain in full force and effect.
