SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 27852, dated March 25, 1935, the Commission authorized the Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company to abandon its station at Clearwater, Los Angeles County, to eliminate said station name from its records, to cancel all rate tariffs and time schedules applying thereto and to abandon and remove the station building at said station.

Applicant, under date of May 9, 1935, has written the Commission that it does not at this time desire to abandon said station as a station of record and cancel rate tariffs and time schedules pertaining thereto, but does desire to remove the station building. Applicant requests a modified order to this effect; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in the Commission's Decision No. 27852 be modified to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its station building at Clearwater, County of Los Angeles, State of California, provided that applicant shall, within thirty

(30) days thereafter notify this Commission in writing of the abandonment of this facility.

"The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
