FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

(formerly Southern California Edison Company) having asked permission to execute a third supplemental indenture for the purpose of further safe-guarding the rights and interests of the holders of bonds issued or to be issued under the original indenture executed under the authority granted by the Commission in Decision No. 12822 dated November 13, 1923, as amended by Decision No. 18202, dated April 7, 1927, and as further amended by Decision No. 27925 dated April 29, 1935, said third supplemental indenture to be substantially in the same form as that filed in this proceeding on June 24, 1935., and the Commission having considered applicant's request and being of the opinion that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company Ltd. be, and it is hereby, authorized to execute a third supplemental indenture substantially in the same form as that filed in the above entitled matter on June 24, 1935; provided that the authority herein granted to execute said third supplemental indenture is for the purpose of this proceeding only and is granted only insofar as this Com-

mission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act to authorize applicant to execute said third supplemental indenture, and is not intended as an approval of said third supplemental indenture as to such other legal requirements to which said third supplemental indenture may be subject.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty(30) days after the execution of the said third supplemental indenture, Southern California Edicon Company Ltd. shall file with the Railroad Commission two (2) certified copies of said third supplemental indenture.
