OPINION and ORDER

Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. requests amendment of paragraph 23 of the order in Decision No. 23244, dated December 31, 1930, on Application No. 16989, permitting applicant to establish an alternate route for service between Shellville and Sonoma through Four Corners or via the highway through Shellville Northwestern Pacific station, Vineburg and Four Corners. The proposed routes are to be used in connection with the substitution of bus for train service of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad on certain schedules between San Francisco and Sonoma, which require the serving of Shellville Northwestern Pacific station and Vineburg. Applicant alleges that the use of the proposed alternate route will effect a saving in time and mileage in the operation of said schedules. No tariff change is contemplated.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to establish an alternate route between Shellville and Sonoma by the amendment of paragraph 23 of the Order in Decision No. 23244, dated December 31, 1930, on Application No. 16989, to read as follows:

"Between Shellville and Sonoma via the main highway through Four Corners, or as an alternate route, when traffic demands require, via the highway through Shellville Northwestern Pacific station, Vineburg and Four Corners, provided that applicant shall file such time schedules as shall make the operation affected in conformity with the General Orders of this Commission."

In all other respects Decision No.23244, dated December 31, 1930, and supplements thereto, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
