

Decision No. 28412.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of
SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF
CALIFORNIA, a corporation, for a
certificate of public convenience
and necessity under Section 50 of
the Public Utilities Act, for author-
ity to extend its facilities and to
exercise permits applied for as and
when granted by the State Highway Commis-
sion of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

In its Decision No. 20308, dated October 9, 1928,
in the above numbered application, this Commission ordered as
follows:

"The Railroad Commission Hereby Further Declares
that hereafter upon the filing of a certified copy of a
permit, or permits, granted to Southern Counties Gas
Company of California by the California Highway Commission,
it will be declared that public convenience and necessity
require and will require the exercise by Southern Counties
Gas Company of California of the rights and privileges
granted by such permits."

The Commission having, on June 28, 1935, received
a copy of Permit No. 51848, issued by the Division of Highways
on October 27, 1928 to Southern Counties Gas Company of California
in compliance with the above recited condition,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas
Company of California be and it is hereby authorized to exercise
the rights and privileges granted to it by such permit; provided
the Railroad Commission of the State of California may hereafter,

by appropriate proceedings and orders, revoke or limit as to territory not then served by Southern Counties Gas Company of California, or its successors in interest, the authority herein granted.

In all other respects Decision No. 20308 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
