ORDER VACATING ORDER INSTITUTING INVESTIGATION
AND SUSPENDING PROPOSED RATE

The Commission by order dated July 10, 1935, suspended until November 5, 1935, Item 6010 of Bay Cities Transportation Company's Supplement No. 8 to its Local Freight Tariff No. 8, C.R.C. No. 8, providing reduced rates for the transportation of freight between San Francisco and Oakland. The item was suspended upon protests from competing common carriers who alleged among other things that the rates therein were unreasonably low and unjustified.

The matter was set for public hearing at San Francisco. Before the proceeding was heard, however, respondent informed the Commission that it desired to withdraw the suspended rates. It accordingly filed Supplement No. 10 to the tariff, cancelling the suspended schedule effective August 24, 1935. The cause for suspension is thus being removed and our order of July 10, 1935, should be vacated and this proceeding discontinued as of August 24, 1935.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that our order of July 10, 1935, in the above entitled proceeding suspending Item 6010 of Bay Cities Transportation Company's Supplement No. 8 to its Local Freight Tariff No. 8, C.R.C. No. 8, be and it is hereby vacated and this proceeding discontinued as of August 24, 1935.
