BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

In this application Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation asks that the Commission make its order declaring that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by applicant of the right, privilege and franchise granted to it by Ordinance No. 236 of the City of Compton, so that it may continue to maintain and operate a section of its gas transmission system consisting of a length of eleven hundred and twenty (1120) feet of eight-inch high pressure main passing through said city.

Applicant has filed with the Commission a resolution, duly passed at a regular meeting of its Board of Directors, to the effect that neither applicant nor its successors or assigns will ever claim, before the Railroad Commission or any other court or public body, a value for the aforesaid franchise in excess of the actual cost thereof, which cost is stated to be two hundred forty-seven dollars and thirty-five cents (\$247.35).

Having carefully considered the request and being of the opinion that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary and that the request should be granted,

The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby certifies and declares that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation of the right and privilege granted to it by Ordinance No. 236 of the City of Compton, provided that the Railroad Commission may hereafter, by appropriate proceedings and orders, revoke or limit as to territory not then served by Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation, or its successors in interest, the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
