## SEVENTE SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By supplemental application in the above entitled proceeding, filed August 29, 1935, applicants, on behalf of carriers participating in Pacific Coastwise Freight Tariff Bureau Tariff No. 1-B, C.R.C. No. 4, seek an order authorizing certain emergency increases in rates on sulphate of alumina, in carloads, named in Items 220 and 1105 of said tariff. It is alleged in the supplemental application that through error these items were omitted from the list of commodity items included in application authorized by Decision No. 28001. It is further alleged that the proposed increases will result in a clarification of the tariff and bring the tariff into harmony with the charges on articles of kindred nature and with the rates of competing rail carriers on the same commodity between the same points, which were established pursuant to the issuance of our original order herein.

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Upon further consideration of the record and the supplemental application, filed August 29, 1935, we are of the opinion that the relief sought should be granted, subject to the same qualifications, conditions and limitations as set forth in the original order (Decision No. 27889, dated April 12, 1935) in this proceeding, good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the above supplemental application, filed August 29, 1935, be and it is hereby granted, subject to the qualifications, conditions and limitations set forth in the original order in this proceeding, said changes to be established on not less than thirty (30) days notice to the Commission and to the public, and only for the period ending June 30, 1936.
