Market Street Railway Company, a corporation, on September 6, 1935, applied for authority to abandon street car service upon and along Fifth Street, between Mission and Brannan Streets, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

Applicant alleges that the Department of Public Works of the State of California, Division of Highways, and the City and County of San Francisco, have requested it to discontinue its street car service upon and along the above described route as an aid to the plan of said Division of Highways for the construction of the San Francisco approach to the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge.

The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, by Ordinance No. 15,091, authorized the abandon-ment of said street car line.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Market Street Railway Company

be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue street car service and remove its tracks upon and along Fifth Street, between Mission and Brannan Streets, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, subject, however, to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this commission, in writing, of the completion of the abandonment herein authorized.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
