FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission on the fifth day of October, 1931, in Decision No. 24107, having authorized Georgeanna Sullivan to lease her Shastina Water Works to W.E. Krum for a period of seven years ending May 31, 1938, and said Georgeanna Sullivan having now asked permission to modify said lease by the cancellation thereof and the making of a new indenture to said W.E. Krum covering a period commencing September 1, 1935, and ending May 31, 1938, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Georgeanna Sullivan, doing business under the fictitious firm name and style of Shastina Water Works, be and she is hereby authorized to cancel the

original lease to W.E. Krum as heretofore authorized and to enter into a new and modified form of lease for the period commencing September 1, 1935, and ending May 31, 1938, as such modified instrument is filed with this Commission and received as of September 24, 1935, said instrument being hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
