ORDER DISMISSING

ORDER INSTITUTING INVESTIGATION AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

By order dated May 6, 1935, in the above entitled proceeding the parties named in the title were ordered to appear before Commissioner Devlin at San Francisco on June 25, 1935, and then and there to show cause, if any they had, why they should not be ordered to cease and desist certain operations unless and until a certificate of public convenience and necessity therefor had been obtained from this Commission.

It became necessary however to defer the hearing to a later date and the Commission has today issued a new order (Case No. 4081) directing the respondents to appear before it on December 3, 1935. This proceeding should therefore be dismissed.
