O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company has requested approval of an agreement between it and the State of California relating to the installation of grade crossing protection at certain crossings on its lines in the State of California. Said installations are proposed in accordance with a general plan of improving grade crossing protection with funds made available by the Federal Government through the State Department of Public Works, and Applicant and said Department of Public Works have entered into an agreement dated September 18th, 1935, providing for the installation of said crossing signals at the expense of the State of California and designating the type of protection to be installed at each crossing.

The crossings affected, together with the present and proposed protection, are set forth in the following tabulation:
