ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

By order in the above entitled proceeding dated July 23, 1935, the Commission suspended until November 18, 1935, reduced rates for the transportation of plumbers' goods between Los Angeles and Santa Barbara published in Item 990-F of Original Page 40-A to Pacific Motor Transport Company's Local Express Tariff No. 9, C.R.C. No. 13. The rates were suspended following receipt of a protest from a competing common carrier alleging among other things that the proposed rates were unreasonably low, non-compensatory, and detrimental to its interests.

The matter was set for public hearing at Los Angeles. Before the proceeding was heard, however, protestant requested that its objections be considered withdrawn and that the proceeding be discontinued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that our order of July 23, 1935, in

the above entitled proceeding suspending Item 990-F of Original Page 40-A to Pacific Motor Transport Company's Local Express Tariff No. 9, C.R.C. No. 13, be and it is hereby vacated and the proceeding discontinued.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
