FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER IN
APPLICATION NO. 15311.

The City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles and Salt Lake Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company, applicants in Application No. 15311 herein, on November 9, 1935, filed with the Commission a request for a further extension of time of six months in which to file the plans covering the construction of a grade separation of Ninth Street, near Lemon Street, with applicant railroad companies' tracks, as authorized by the Commission in its Decision No. 21090, dated May 15, 1929. In the petition for extension of time it is set forth that the City of Los Angeles has now taken steps to abandon the condemnation suit to condemn abutters' damage in connection with the 9th Street

grade separation. The matter of costs in connection with that suit and other matters in connection with the proposed grade separation are still pending, and it is desired that Decision No. 21090 be kept in effect until the various matters in connection with the proposed grade separation are straightened out.

It appears that this request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of said Decision No. 21090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (3) The City of Los Angeles shall, on or before July 1, 1936, and before the commencement of the construction of said separation, file with the Commission, for its approval, a set of plans for the construction of said separation on Ninth Street near Lemon Street.

In all other respects Decision No. 21090 shall remain in full force and effect.
