In the Matter of the Application of the SAN DIEGO & ARIZONA EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY to install additional grade crossing protection at crossing of Imperial Avenue in El Centro, Imperial County (C.R.C. Crossing No. 36-146.8) with its main track.

O R D E R

San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company has applied for authority to install two Flashing Light Signals of the type known as the A.R.A. Standard, at the crossing of Imperial Highway (Crossing No. 36-146.8) with its tracks in the vicinity of El Centro, Imperial County. The cost of installing the signals will be borne by funds made available for the purpose by the Federal Government and the type of signal proposed has the approval of Federal Bureau of Public Roads.

It appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company is hereby authorized to install two (2) Flashing Light Signals of the type approved by the Bureau of Public Roads of the Department of Agriculture, for the protection of Crossing No. 36-146.8.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
