BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of A. W. WAY for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport property, as a common carrier, for compensation, over the public highways between Arcata, Eureka, Scotia, Loleta, Ferndale, Fernbridge, Fortuna, Alton, Garberville, Willits and intermediate points, on the one hand, and Santa Rosa, Petaluma, San Francisco and South San Francisco, on the other hand, via the Redwood Highway, as an enlargement and extension of applicant's existing operative rights between Ferndale and Eureka, and intermediate points, via Loleta, and between Ferndale and Upper Mattole, and intermediate points, via Petrolia.

FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The applicant herein has requested that the Commission amend its Decision No. 28268 in Application No. 19612 granting an extension of time for the transportation of fresh meats and meat products under refrigeration between Eureka and Willits for delivery to the Quartermaster Warehouse, Camp Northwestern, Willits, California. The sale and delivery of fresh meats to the Quartermaster's Warehouse is handled on a month to month basis and this service is of a temporary emergency nature and it appears that the request should be granted.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph one (1) on page two (2) of Decision No. 28268 dated October 7, 1935, on the application herein, be and the same is amended to read as follows:

"Applicant shall be permitted to transport at a rate of fifty (50) cents per one hundred (100) pounds, fresh meat and meat products, southbound only, between Eureka and Willits, delivering same to the Quartermaster Warehouse, Camp Northwestern, Willits, California, until February 1, 1936 or such further time as may be granted by subsequent order."

In all other respects said decision shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
