FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

A. W. Nickell operating an automotive service, under the name and style Nickell Transfer Co., for the transportation of property between San Jose, San Francisco, Oakland, East Bay cities and Los Angeles has in writing requested authority to further temporarily suspend all his service for an additional period of six (6) months.

Applicant justifies his request on the ground that a continuing illness prevents his operation.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and the application will be granted.

under the name and style Nickell Transfer Co., be, and he is hereby, authorized to further suspend all his operations until June 30, 1936, provided that applicant supplement his tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Commission to show that his service has been temporarily suspended as authorized herein, and provided further that applicant shall elect, during such period of suspension, to either restore said service on

or bofore the expiration date of said period or to relinquish his operating right.

This order shall become effective as of the date hereof.
