BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of the San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company, a corporation, for permission to remove certain spur track in the County of San Diego, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company, a corporation, on December 23, 1935, applied for authority to abandon and remove a spur track located on its right of way at Mile Post 10.35 in the County of San Diego, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said spur track was constructed for the purpose of connecting and did connect with and serve a private industrial railroad owned and operated by the Spreckels Commercial Company; that said private industrial railroad has been abandoned and removed; and that said spur track no longer serves any industry.

It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to abandon and remove a spur track located on its right of way at Mile Post 10.35 in the County of San Diego, State of California, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission, in writing, of the removal of said spur track.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
