IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph one of the order in
Decision No. 28503, dated January 15, 1936, reading-

" Mt. Lassen Transit Company, having asked permission to
issue a note for \$3,000.00 to Bank of America, National Trust
and Savings Association, payable, principal and interest, in
monthly installments of \$59.78 and for permission to use the
proceeds to improve and re-model the building known as the
Nataqua Building, located on Main Street in Westwood, so that
said building can be used by applicant in the conduct of
its business; "
